Day 1 (Wed) July 20: Vancouver Arrival

Arrive in Vancouver! Your motorcoach picks you up from the airport and you will enjoy a short sightseeing tour of Vancouver. Highlights include Vancouver's highest viewpoint at Queen Elizabeth Park where you will have free time to stroll through the Sunken Gardens. Then, off to Gastown and North America's second largest Chinatown and continue to visit the world famous 1,000 acre Stanley Park. A stop will be made at the Totem Poles and Prospect Point, which offer a spectacular view of Lions Gate Bridge. After the tour, you will check into your hotel.

Day 2 (Thu) July 21: Day trip to Whistler, BC and site of 2010 Olympics

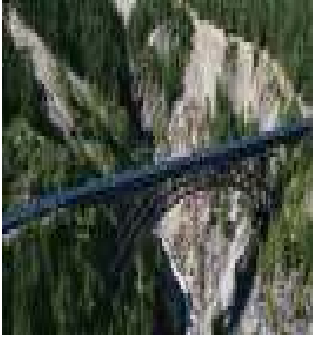
Travel by motorcoach on the Sea to Sky highway from the coastal city of Vancouver to the resort town of Whistler, renowned for outstanding skiing and year-round outdoor activities. Highlights of the trip include spectacular views of Howe Sound and the Coast Mountains, Shannon Falls, Mount Garibaldi and the impressive Cheakamus Canyon. Enjoy a guided sightseeing tour of the 2010 Olympic site. Return to Vancouver in the late afternoon. *(Meals: on your own) Overnight in Vancouver.*



Day 3: (Fri) July 22: Vancouver to Kamloops

Your motorcoach will transfer your group to the rail station. Travel onboard the Rocky Mountaineer from Vancouver to Kamloops, in the heart of British Columbia's interior. Breakfast and lunch are served onboard. On today's journey you will see dramatic changes in scenery, from the lush green fields of the Fraser River valley, through forests and winding river canyons surrounded by the peaks of the Coast and Cascade mountains, to the desert-like environment of the interior. Highlights include the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon and the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River. Enjoy dinner tonight at the Rhythms on the Rails show.

Day 4 (Sat) July 23: Kamloops to Jasper

Your journey continues North and East to the mighty Canadian Rockies and the province of Alberta. Breakfast and lunch are served onboard. Once again you will be surrounded by dramatic scenery as you follow the banks of the North Thompson River through the Monashee and Cariboo mountains, climbing ever nearer to the high peaks of the Continental Divide. Today's highlights include Mount Robson, at 3,954 metres (12,972 feet) the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies, Pyramid Falls, and the climb over the Yellowhead Pass into Jasper National Park. Your rail journey ends on arrival in the resort town of Jasper this evening .

Day 5 (Sun) July 24: Jasper to Banff

After breakfast at your hotel, travel toward Lake Louise via one of the most scenic highways in the world, the Icefields Parkway. Here you will ride on an Ice Explorer to the middle of the Athabasca Glacier to learn more about its geological features. Your driver/guide will explain how glaciers are formed and point out some interesting geological features. Afterwards, a brief stop will be made at Bow Lake before arriving in Banff.

Day 6 (Mon) July 25: Banff to Lake Louise

After breakfast this morning you will embark on a tour that takes you into Yoho National Park to view some of its natural wonders. Among the attractions are the Spiral Tunnels, Emerald Lake and a natural rock bridge that spans the Kicking Horse River. Upon arrival into Lake Louise, you will enjoy a spectacular lunch at the famous Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise. Returning to Banff, you will have a short sightseeing tour that includes Lake Minnewanka, Surprise Corner and the Hoodoos.

Day 7 (Tue) July 26: Banff to Calgary Airport

After breakfast early this morning, you will be transferred to the Calgary airport in time for your departure home. **(Breakfast)**

- **Yoho National Park Tour:** View the majestic wonders of this park nestled in the Canadian Rockies with highlights including the Spiral tunnels, Emerald Lake and a natural rock bridge that spans the Kicking Horse River.
- **Icefields Parkway Tour:** Experience the Icefields Parkway, one of the most scenic roadways in the Canada, and one of the most spectacular mountain highways in the world. The Columbia Icefield is the Parkway's crown jewel where you will embark upon an ice explorer on a glacier. Part of your Icefields Parkway Tour you will board a unique specially designed Ice Explorer for a 90 minute guided tour onto the surface of the Athabasca Glacier. Your driver/ guide will explain how glaciers are formed and point out interesting geological features as you travel in safety and comfort.
- **Banff Tour:** In Canada's oldest national park you'll learn about the natural attractions of the windshaped hoodoos which tower majestically over the valley. Visit the classic viewpoints of Surprise Corner along Tunnel Mountain Drive Lake Minnewanka and Bow Falls. Learn the story of how these majestic mountains have shaped this unique community.
